ROYAL MARINE HOTEL, DÚN LAOGHAIRE

Location

The Royal Marine overlooks Dublin Bay and has direct access to Dún Laoghaire Promenade and Pier. It boasts a health club, spa, indoor pool and air-conditioned rooms with free Wi-Fi.

There is a DART train line within a few minutes walk from the Royal Marine, which has regular services to Dublin City. From outside the hotel there is a coach service to and from Dublin Airport. The Pier Health Club has a steam room, spa bath and freeweights. A range of indulgent treatments are on offer at the Sansana Spa including a rock sauna, a mud room and experience showers. ovember 2022

There are plenty of beautiful coastal and countryside walks, including Peoples Park, in the immediate vicinity. Free parking is available at the hotel.

Air Coach

A coach service is available to and from Dublin Airport. The closest stop to the hotel is on Marine Road, only a 2-minute walk from the hotel. The route is the 703 to and from Killiney, with a journey time of approximately 40 minutes and represents the best value transport option between the airport and the Royal Marine Hotel. The Aircoach Dublin Airport stop is located outside the Arrivals Halls at both Terminal 1 and Terminal 2. It is recommended that you book in advance online. By Train

The DART runs approximately every 5 minutes during rush hour periods and every 20 mins at other times of the day from Dublin City Centre to Dún Laoghaire. The journey offers stunning views of the South East Coast. Irish Rail is the national rail service and operates a regular service throughout the country. The DART links up with Irish Rail at Connolly Station, as it does with The LUAS tram service. By Bus

Dún Laoghaire is serviced by Dublin Bus. The terminus is located at the DART station. Night link services run every hour on the hour from Trinity College between midnight and 3am.




Travel by Car

From the M50 Motorway, travelling Southbound


Leave the M50 at junction 13, and merge onto the N31/Leopardstown Road. Click on the image below to access specific directions from this point.




Travel by Car

Things To Do



- Walk along the pier in Dun Laoghaire Harbour and enjoy the scenic views, the natural flora and fauna. Stop for an ice-cream or hot chocolate on the way back.
- At sunset visit the Victorian bandstand and take in the magical silhouettes against the darkening skies.
- Visit the James Joyce Tower and Museum. This tower inspired the setting of the first chapter of Ulysses.
- Walk along the seafront to Sandycove and visit the Forty Foot where you are guaranteed to find someone swimming any day of the year.

- Visit the National Maritime museum inside the 180-year old mariners church.
- Visit one of the restaurants along the harbour or enjoy a Guinness or a tot of Whiskey in one of the Irish pubs.
- Close to Dun Laoghraire you can take the DART to Dalkey and Killiney Hill. Walk along the coast through several trails. This is known as one of the most beautiful places and celebrities like Bono, Van Morrison, Enya and Matt Damon have homes here.
- You can also take a trip to Howth and Malahide for more great walks.


Dublin

Dublin city centre is only twenty minutes away from Dun Laoghraire by DART train. Don't miss out on the Welcome Reception that will be held at Trinity College Dublin on Wednesday 9th November 2022.

Visit the library at Trinity College which is home to the famous Book of Kells, an ornate beautifully illuminated manuscript containing all the four gospels.

While in Dublin you can visit the many sites the city has to offer such as Dublin Castle, and the marvellous architecture of St. Patrick's cathedral. Take a walk over the Ha'penny bridge and admire its unique beauty. Enjoy a stroll in St. Stephen's Green or catch a play at one of the many theatres.

If you're in a mood for a pint or two, walk to the Temple Bar area or book a tour of the Guiness factory. There's no better place to take in a party atmosphere.
