The conference registration desk will be located outside the Carlisle Suite on the ground floor of the Royal Marine Hotel and will be open as follows:

Saturday 12 Nov: 08:00 – 12:00

Please note, other than poster presentations and keynote speakers, there is no need for you to submit your presentation in advance. You should bring your presentation with you on a data stick. There will be no speaker preparation room at the conference so if you need to edit your presentation please bring your own device on which to do so as content is not being managed centrally. If you are a Mac/Apple user, please bring your own adapter and it will also be best to save your presentation as a pdf file as the laptops provided at the conference are all Windows based PCs.

You may set your poster up in the Carlisle West Suite on Thursday 10 November between 08:00 – 11:30. Velcro will be supplied to affix your poster to a board but please note there are no printing facilities on site, you are required to bring your printed poster with you.

Please note that any posters not removed by 13:00 on Saturday, 12 November cannot be stored by the Conference Organisers and will be disposed of.

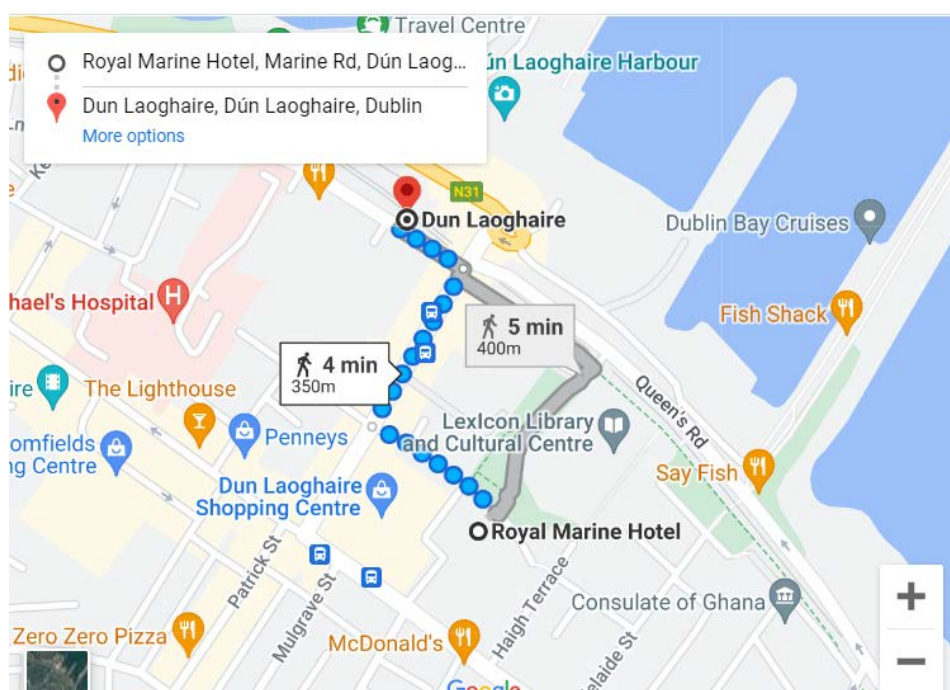
TRAVEL INFORMATION

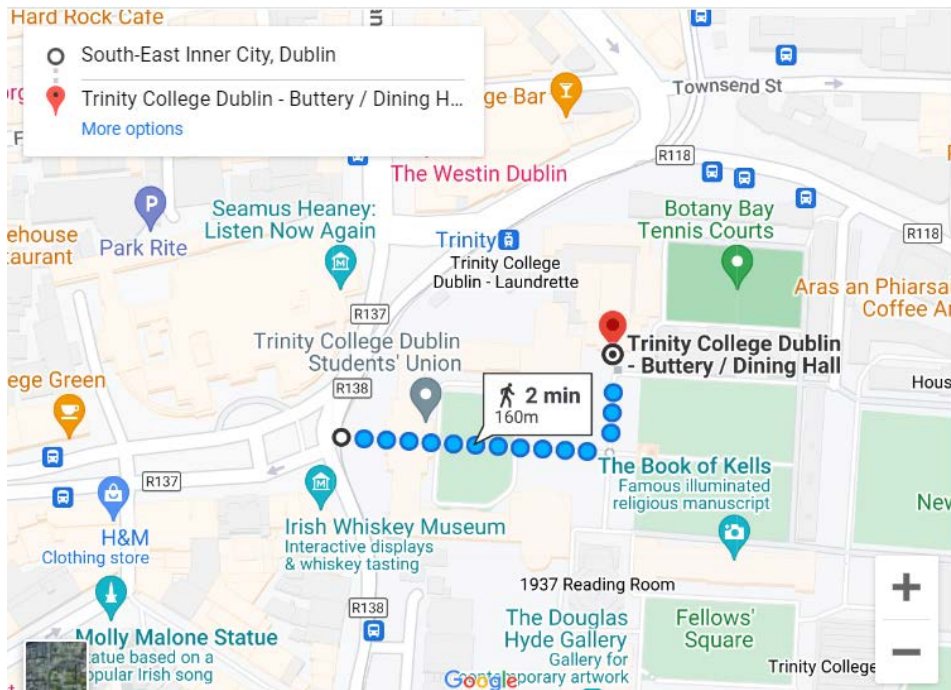

If you are taking a taxi, we recommend using the [FreeNow app](#).

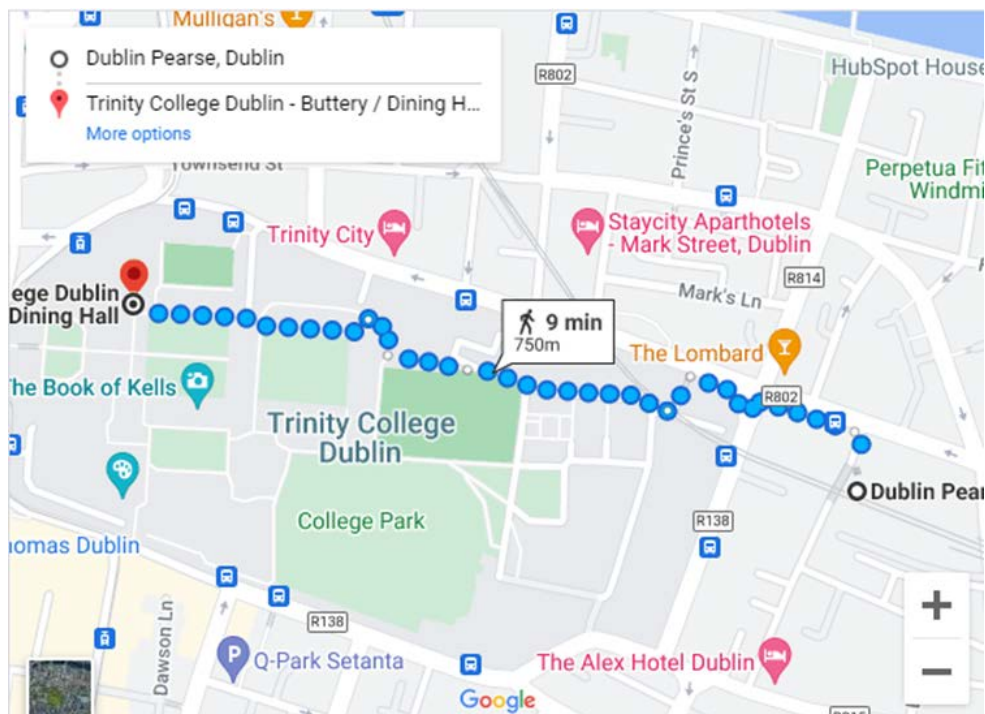
If you would like to take public transport, you can use [Google Maps](#) or download the [JourneyPlanner app](#) for timetables. With a [LeapCard](#) you can use the bus, LUAS (tram) and DART (commuter train) at discounted rates. This means, you do not need to purchase tickets each time or carry cash and coins. Simply tag the “beeping” devices with your card when you get on and off. Leap Visitor Cards are available for 1, 3 or 7 days and [can be purchased](#) at Dublin Airport and throughout Dublin City. From/to Dublin Airport you can also buy a ticket for one of the [Aircoach routes](#).

The Conference Welcome Reception will take place in the Dining Hall, Trinity College Dublin, on Wednesday 9 November from 19:00 – 20:30. The easiest way to travel to Trinity College from the Royal Marine Dublin is by DART. You should travel northbound from Dún Laoghaire to Pearse Station in Dublin City Centre. Please see below for walking maps from the Royal Marine Hotel to Dún Laoghaire DART station and from Pearse Station to the Dining Hall in Trinity College Dublin.
