

ROYAL MARINE HOTEL, DÚN LAOGHAIRE

LOCATION

The Royal Marine overlooks Dublin Bay and has direct access to Dún Laoghaire Promenade and Pier. It boasts a health club, spa, indoor pool and air-conditioned rooms with free Wi-Fi. There is a DART train line within a few minutes walk from the Royal Marine, which has regular services to Dublin City. From outside the hotel there is a coach service to and from Dublin Airport. The Pier Health Club has a steam room, spa bath and freeweights. A range of indulgent treatments are on offer at the Sansana Spa including a rock sauna, a mud room and experience showers.

There are plenty of beautiful coastal and countryside walks, including Peoples Park, in the immediate vicinity. Free parking is available at the hotel.

DIRECTIONS ON PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Aircoach

A coach service is available to and from Dublin Airport. The closest stop to the hotel is on Marine Road, only a 2-minute walk from the hotel. The route is the 703 to and from Killiney, with a journey time of approximately 40 minutes and represents the best value transport option between the airport and the Royal Marine Hotel. The Aircoach Dublin Airport stop is located outside the Arrivals Halls at both Terminal 1 and Terminal 2. It is recommended that you book in advance online. By Train

The DART runs approximately every 5 minutes during rush hour periods and every 20 mins at other times of the day from Dublin City Centre to Dún Laoghaire. The journey offers stunning views of the South East Coast. Irish Rail is the national rail service and operates a regular service throughout the country. The DART links up with Irish Rail at Connolly Station, as it does with The LUAS tram service. By Bus

Dún Laoghaire is serviced by Dublin Bus. The terminus is located at the DART station. Night link services run every hour on the hour from Trinity College between midnight and 3am.

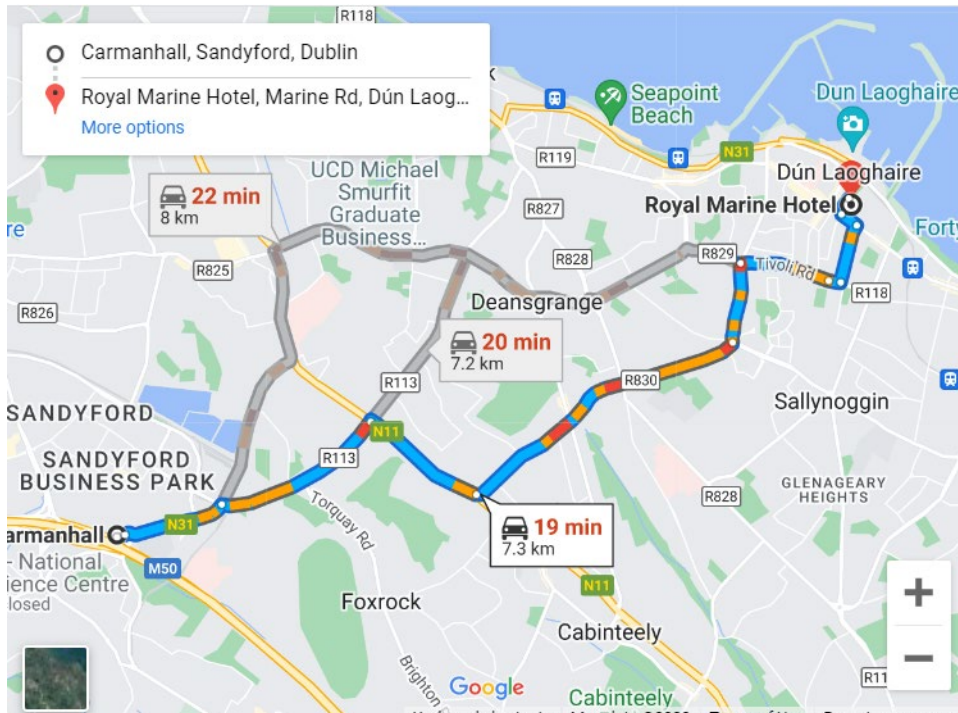

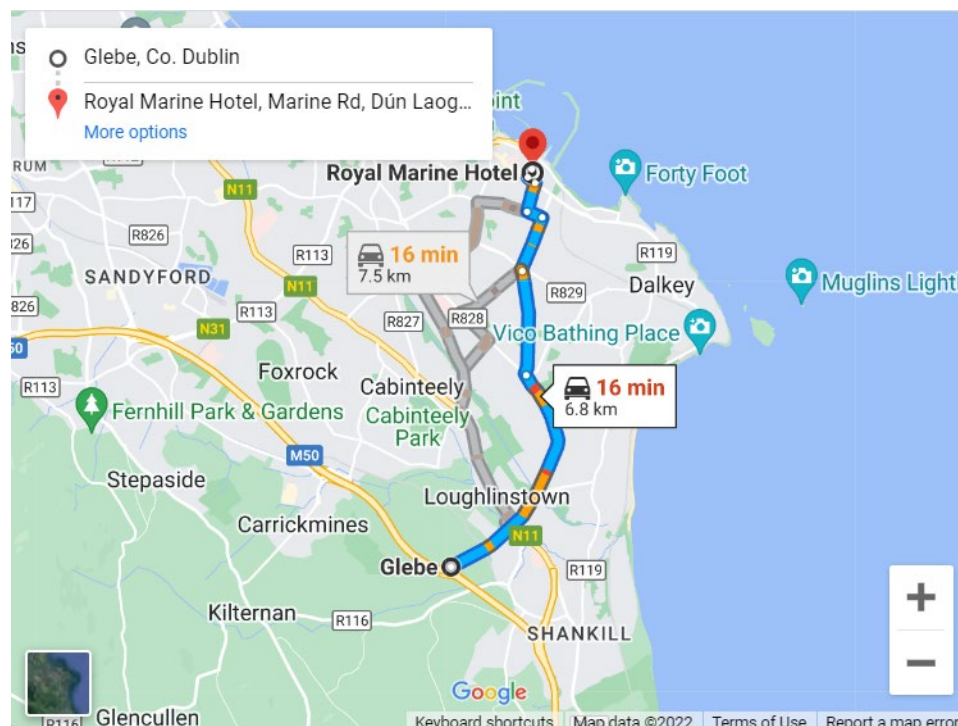
From the M50 Motorway, travelling Southbound
